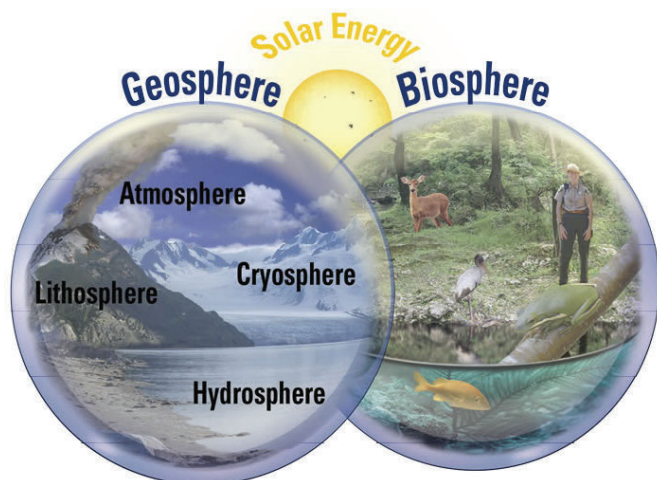

Registration and fee

Everyone needs to register **by 15 August**. Registration can be done through the society's website (www.ngfweb.no/aarsmote.html) or by sending an email to the treasurer Jan Even Øie Nilsen (even@nersc.no). If you send an email, remember to give your arrival and departure times, name(s) of participant(s), and which meals you will eat at the symposium.

Payment will be made to the society's treasurer and includes the meeting fee plus accommodation and meals. Full participation for the two days, with hotel room, is kr 2895 for ordinary participants. We also allow for shorter participation or full participation without accommodation. Accommodation costs kr 1095 (with breakfast); attendance costs 600 per day (with lunch); the formal dinner costs 600 (making full participation without accommodation 1800). Accompanying persons and retirees pay kr 1200 for lunches and dinner, plus any accommodation costs.
